A. MOTION TO RECOMMEND ADOPTION of the 2022 Transportation Alternatives (TA) Program Project Application Rankings

The purpose of the TPA’s TA program is to help fund connected infrastructure for non-motorized users, such as sidewalks, bicycle facilities, Complete Streets projects, and other safety related transportation infrastructure. A. Brightline Update

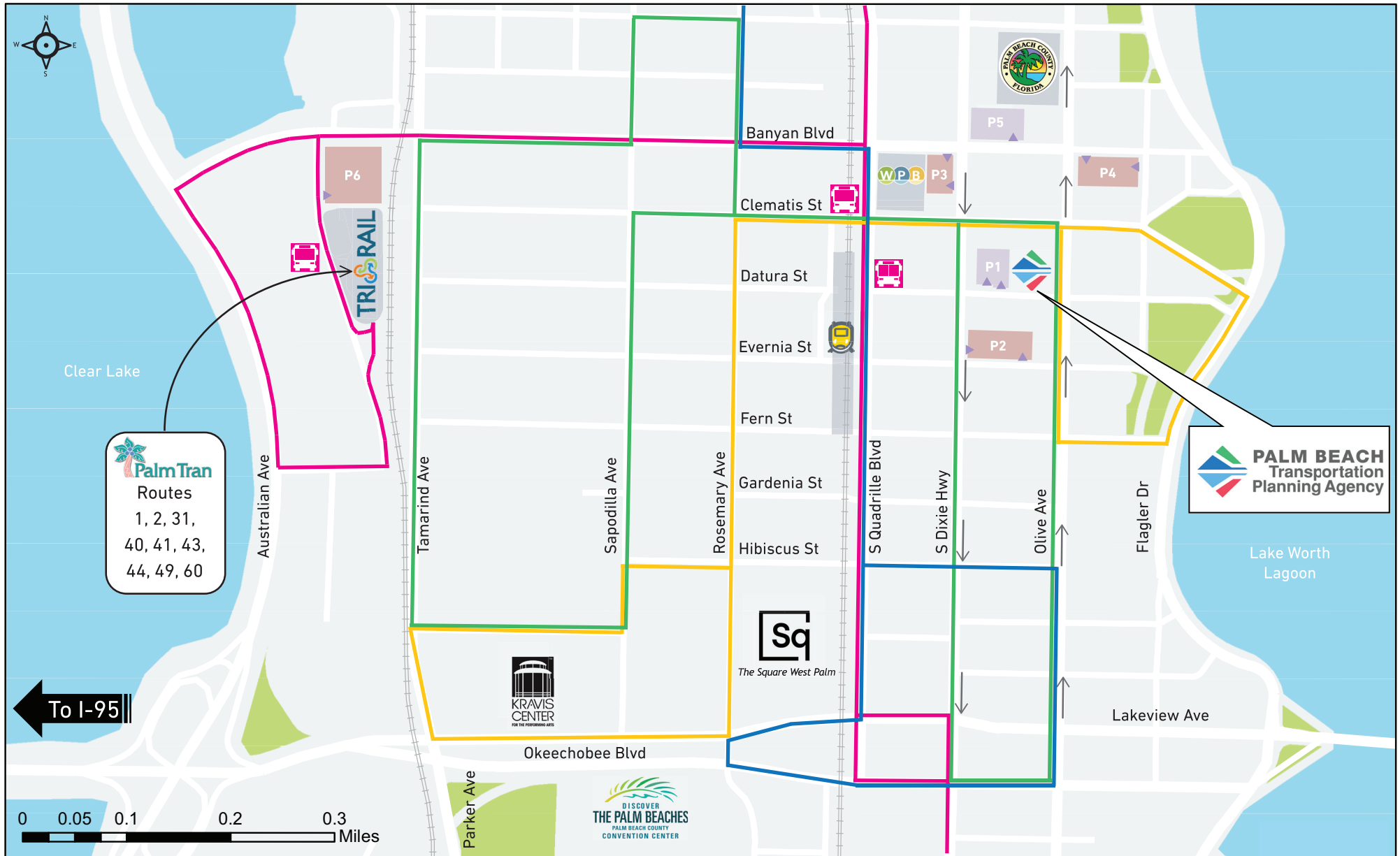
Brightline staff will provide an update regarding safety, quiet zones, new developments, and construction progress. The draft presentation is attached.
