The TAC provides technical review, comments and recommendations regarding items to be considered by the TPA Governing Board, including transportation plans, programs, studies, and other appropriate documents and regional transportation issues.

TAC - Staff Recommendation

Section 3.1 Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) Role and Function

Pursuant to Section 339.175(6)(d), F.S., the TAC provides technical review, comments and recommendations regarding items to be considered by the TPA Governing Board, including transportation plans, programs, studies, and other appropriate documents and regional transportation issues. The TAC addresses other matters and concerns when directed by the TPA Governing Board. It shall be the function of the TAC to provide technical review and make recommendations to the TPA Governing Board regarding:

- Long Range Transportation Plans (LRTP) goals, objectives, performance measures, targets and desired and cost feasible projects and programs;
- Priority Project Lists, Transportation Improvement Programs (TIP), and Unified Planning Work Programs (UPWP);
- Objective Scoring system used to rank project applications submitted for funding through the annual Local Initiatives (LI) Program and State Road Modifications Program (SRM);
- Other TPA-led transportation plans, studies and reports;
- Transportation plans, studies, reports, and project designs presented to the TPA by partner agencies (FDOT, PBC Engineering, Municipalities, SFRTA, Palm Tran, Seaport, Airport, etc.);
- Regional transportation plans, studies, reports, and projects; and
- Proposed TPA policy or position statements.

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Citizen's Advisory Committee

The Citizen's Advisory Committee (CAC) is responsible for providing the TPA Board with a "citizen's eye" view of ongoing transportation issues in Palm Beach County.

Because one of the base missions of the TPA is to gather local input and desires for transportation within the County, this committee is an important conduit for serving these public interests and submitting their views and concerns to the TPA Board.



Must reflect a broad cross-section of local residents with an interest in the development of an efficient, safe, and cost-effective transportation system. Minorities, the elderly, and the handicapped must be adequately represented.



Citizen's Advisory Committee

Role and Function

- Review transportation plans
- Share concerns of various segments of the community

Membership

- 1 representative per Governing Board member (currently 5 vacancies)
- Governing Board <u>required</u> to ensure representation of minorities, elderly, and persons with disabilities
- Membership also sought to represent environmental, business & construction, development, freight & goods, private transportation, general public

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How the TPA meets Federal & State requirements for CAC

TPA committee survey to track representation of demographic/social indicators (ex. minority, disability, elderly, business community)

- 4 minority
- 7 elderly
- 1 person with a disability

Governing Board members should choose appointments based on the need for minorities, elderly, and persons with disabilities

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Vision Zero Advisory Committee

The TPA's Vision Zero Advisory Committee (VZAC), formally known as the Bicycle, Trailways Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BTPAC), serves in an advisory capacity to the TPA Governing Board to advance those elements of the TPA's Vision Zero Action Plan oriented around pedestrian and bicycle safety, and to address other matters and concerns when directed by the TPA Board.



Members consist of representatives from local governments, law enforcement and fire rescues services, school district, health department, active transportation advocacy groups, and other entities as deemed appropriate by the TPA Board to advance those elements of the TPA's Vision Zero Action Plan oriented around pedestrian and bicycle safety.



VZAC - Staff Recommendation

Section 5.1 Vision Zero Advisory Committee (VZAC) Role and Function

The VZAC serves in an advisory capacity to the TPA Governing Board to advance those elements of the TPA's Vision Zero Action Plan oriented around pedestrian and bicycle safety, and to address other matters and concerns when directed by the TPA. It shall be the function of the VZAC to review and make recommendations to the TPA Governing Board regarding the non-motorized elements of:

- <u>Objective Scoring system used to rank project</u> applications submitted for funding through the annual Transportation Alternatives Program and <u>project rankings (including review, evaluation, and ranking);</u>
- The TPA's Long Range Transportation Plans (LRTP), Priority Project Lists, Transportation Improvement Programs (TIP), and Unified Planning Work Programs (UPWP);
- Other TPA-led transportation plans, studies and reports;
- Transportation plans, studies, reports, and project designs presented to the TPA by partner agencies (FDOT, PBC Engineering, Municipalities, SFRTA, Palm Tran, Seaport, Airport, etc.);
- Regional transportation plans, studies, reports, and projects; and
- Other items of interest as determine by the TPA or the VZAC.

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
