2.A. <u>RECOMMENDED APPROVAL</u>: Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-2024 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

MATTHEW KOMMA, TPA Chief Financial Officer, provided a PowerPoint presentation that can be viewed at PalmBeachTPA.org/TAC. Matthew reviewed the final UPWP, which is the 2-year business plan and budget for the agency covering a period of July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2024. The UPWP serves as the TPA's application for federal planning funds and includes a description of the planning work, deliverables, timeframes, and source and amount of funding requested. Matthew reviewed key updates made between the previously presented draft document and the final version scheduled for adoption on May 19, 2022.

There were no public or member comments on this item.

MOTION to approve the FY 2023-2024 UPWP made by Michael O'Dell, seconded by Aaron Hoffman, and carried unanimously 21-0 as depicted in the table below.

3. INFORMATION ITEMS

3.A. <u>DISCUSSED</u>: Draft FY 23-27 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

JASON PRICE, TPA TIP Coordinator, provided a PowerPoint presentation that can be viewed at PalmBeachTPA.org/TAC. Jason reviewed the TIP, which is the TPA's five-year funding program for transportation projects in Palm Beach County. Jason noted this was developed in collaboration with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and various local agencies and includes transportation projects funded by federal, state, and local sources for all modes of transportation. The program reflects revenue expectations for the next five fiscal years and shows phases and funding sources by year for each project. The full TIP document and appendices can be viewed at PalmBeachTPA.org/TIP.

Vicki Gatanis joined the meeting in-person.

There were no public comments on this matter.

Member discussion ensued regarding the correlation between the TIP and the Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) and future updates to both documents, project status of the extension of commuter rail to northern Palm Beach County, project update for the Atlantic Avenue Project Development and Environmental (PD&E) Study, cancellation of a Town of Palm Beach project and the process followed for any projects that are cancelled, and the Tri-Rail extension project to the VA.

TERRENCE BAILEY requested a summary table be provided in the UPWP that shows a correlation between the LRTP and TIP.

ALEX HANSEN expressed concerns on the Tri-Rail northern extension project as it has remained stagnant for some time and initiated discussion on potential next steps.

MOTION to request the TPA Governing Board make a resolution to Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners to authorize a countywide referendum for a dedicated funding source for operational dollars for Tri-Rail Coastal Link project (FM# 4170317). Motion made by Terrence Bailey and seconded by Alex Hansen.

Member discussion ensued regarding the feasibility of a dedicated funding source and the steps that have already occurred on this project, including a TPA Governing Board Subcommittee that discussed this item in detail previously.

SUBSTITUTE MOTION to request the TPA Governing Board make a resolution to the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners to authorize a countywide referendum to create a dedicated source of operating funding to support the 561 Plan with specific emphasis on the northern extension of Tri-Rail project (FM# 4170317). Motion made by Christopher Marsh and seconded by Michael O'Dell.

Further member discussion ensued regarding this project and concerns about the feasibility of a funding source especially with other County ballot initiatives pending, as well as concerns that the motion was being too inclusive of additional projects and not focused on the Tri-Rail project alone as intended with the original motion.

The substitute motion was called to question and a roll call vote was taken. The motion passed 18-4 as depicted in the table below.
