## Board Apportionment

**BACKGROUND:** The TPA Governing Board currently has 21 members.

- On June 6, 2022, the Executive Committee asked if the TPA Governing Board could have more members

**ANSWER:** The TPA is authorized pursuant to Florida law to have up to 25 members.

- Membership is determined by agreement between the Governor and the affected units of local government. Expansion of the TPA Governing Board would allow up to four (4) additional Governing Board seats.
- At least 5 County Commissioners need to serve as Governing Board members to meet min. threshold.
- TPA Governing Board could consider alternate members and an alternating membership?
- Florida law states "the exact number [of members is] determined on an equitable geographic-population ratio basis, based on an agreement among the affected units of general-purpose local government and the Governor..." §339.175(3)(a).
