Federally-mandated agency with Governing Board of 21 locally elected officials












































Roadway Miles






























- Key Planning Documents

- 25-year Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP)
 - Evaluates how and where we will grow and identifies cost-feasible needs & desires
- 5-year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)
 - Directly prioritizes over \$50 million in federal/state funds annually Approve all federal/state funding in Palm Beach County \$600 Million annually
- 1-year Strategic Plan
 - Corridor studies, walk bike transit access safety audits, public engagement initiatives

Complete Streets - safe access for transportation users of all ages and abilities




Vision Zero – commitment to zero trafficrelated fatalities and serious injuries

Mode Shift – Grow walking, bicycling, and transit ridership to maximize efficiency and enhance prosperity








Regional Transportation Network

Frequent limited stop service, branded vehicles and stations, level boarding, off-board fare payment, transit signal priority

Light Rail Transit (LRT)



Primarily operates in dedicated rail lanes

Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)



Primarily operates in dedicated bus lanes

BRT Lite



Primarily operates in mixed traffic




Mobility Vision Next Steps

- Conduct 561 Plan multimodal corridor planning studies
- Refine Mobility Vision with local municipalities and partners
- Determine total cost and funding options
- Create roadmap with partners for implementation
- Assist with local Complete Streets, Mobility, & Safety Projects
- Integrate transportation & land uses to promote redevelopment, transit-oriented development, and "car-optional" communities
