


Rental price increase from 2021 to 2022 (for 1-bedroom apartment)

2021 Housing Rent in West Palm Beach averaged **\$1300**/month (for a 1-bedroom apartment)


What wage do you need in order to afford a modest apartment?

BY STATE

California, Hawaii and Massachusetts top the list when it comes to the hourly wage one would need to afford rent on a modest two-bedroom apartment. Only two states - West Virginia and Arkansas - came in with an affordability wage of below \$15 per hour. Florida ranked twelfth with residents needing to earn \$24.82 an hour.

Housing: Solutions to Consider

Location-efficient housing (TOD)

New housing models to address the "missing middle"

Per unit energy costs decrease with higher density housing.

Transportation costs decrease with location efficiency.

Allion BTU Per Year

Both enable the purchase of more housing/housing affordability.

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



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
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Resiliency and Future Proofing

of greenhouse gas emissions. This varies by region. In Miami, transportation is responsible for **43%**.



Additional Floridians at risk of flooding by 2050 (Over the 3.5M at risk today)








Resiliency: Solutions to Consider

Enable zero-emission mobility. Provide multiple connections. Increase shade, decrease pavement.





Gridded networks with multiple crossings increase resilience.



Issue	<u>Unpleasant to walk or bike in the heat.</u>	<u>Need for redundant routes/resiliency in the</u> event of major weather event.
